Any student who is planning advanced education, and whose legal residence is in the Town of Pomfret, CT may apply for financial aid from The William and Gladys Murdock Scholarship Fund.

The applicant should be a member of a high school graduation class, or in any undergraduate class of an accredited school of higher learning, and in the top one-third of his/her high school class or maintaining satisfactory grades in his/her college classes. Preference will be given to those students who have graduated from Pomfret Community School, and to those students who are seeking a career in education.

The applicant must have received acceptance from or be attending an accredited educational institution.


The amount of aid will be determined upon the need and the number of applicants. Funds will be paid directly to the educational institution the recipient plans to attend, when the administering board is notified that the recipient is in attendance.

The application must be completed and mailed or personally delivered to the principal's office no later than April 28, 2017 along with:

1. A transcript of the student's record and recommendation from the school last attended.
2. Two (2) letters of reference other than school personnel.
